### 2022 MISSOURI WINTER WHEAT VARIETY TEST

Soft red winter wheat tests will be offered at 10 locations in Missouri this year: four in the North region, three in the Southwest region, and three in the Southeast region. Every possible effort will be made to plant, harvest, and report data for each entry accepted. However, no refund of testing fees will be made for data lost due to circumstances beyond our control.

A variety may be entered in as many regions as desired, but within a region it will be tested at all locations. Seeding rate will be 1.5 million seeds per acre (approx. 1.75 bu.) for all tests. Please send <u>five pounds of seed</u> for each entry in each region and <u>include SDS sheets for any seed treatment applied.</u>

The fee schedule for the winter wheat tests will be \$105 per entry per location. An additional charge of 5% of the total is required by the University of Missouri. The deadline for applications and payments is **Sept. 2**, and the deadline for seed is **Sept. 16**. Please make checks payable to **UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI**
